
Step to Making a Green Screen Video

- 3. Find photos and videos to add to your green screen recording <u>PowerDirector Steps</u>
- 4. Import Media
- 5. Remove Noise
- 6. Cut beginning, end and any errors
- 7. Delete green screen
- 8. Add import photo and/or video
- 9. Change the speed and the length of the Import videos/photos
- 10. Add transition each frame
- 11. Add text
- 12. Remove sound if need be
- 13. Move to the next frame and repeat steps 8-12.





- 6. Click a green color


