



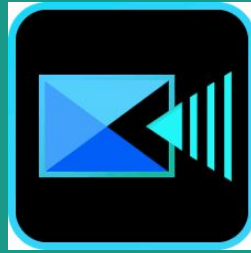

Step to Making a Green Screen Video

1. Record the green screen
2. Make a new folder and title it
3. Find photos and videos to add to your green screen recording
PowerDirector Steps
4. Import Media
5. Remove Noise
6. Cut beginning, end and any errors
7. Delete green screen
8. Add import photo and/or video
9. Change the speed and the length of the Import videos/photos
10. Add transition each frame
11. Add text
12. Remove sound if need be
13. Move to the next frame and repeat steps 8- 12.

4. Click Full Mode

Click the Clip>> Right Click>> Audio Editor>> Noise Reduction

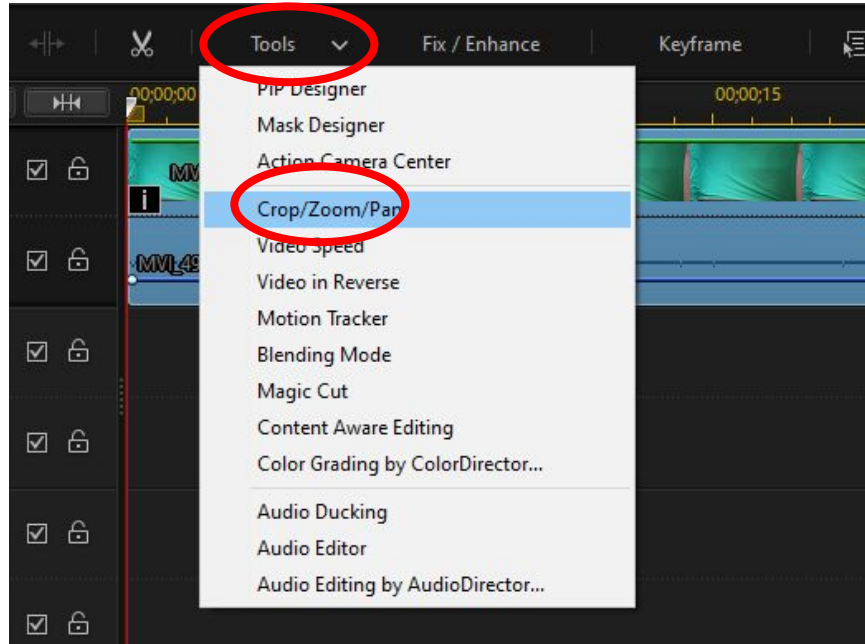

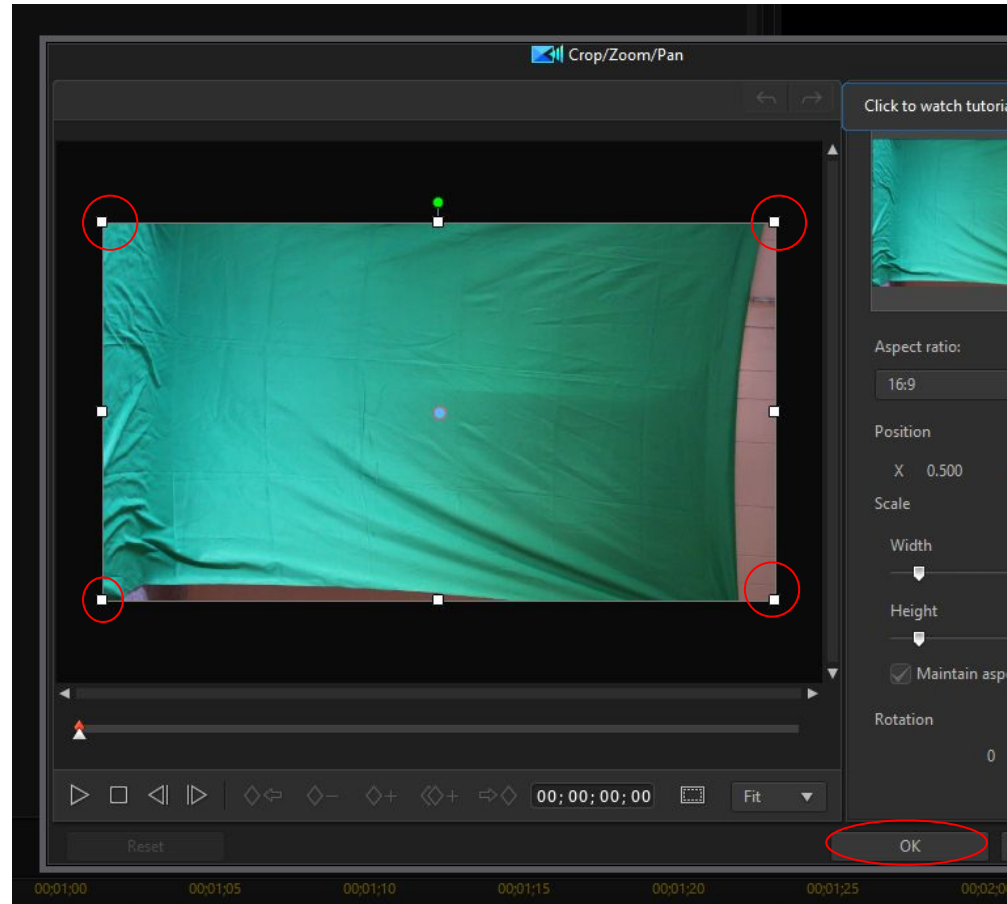


- Choose Noise type

- Click OK

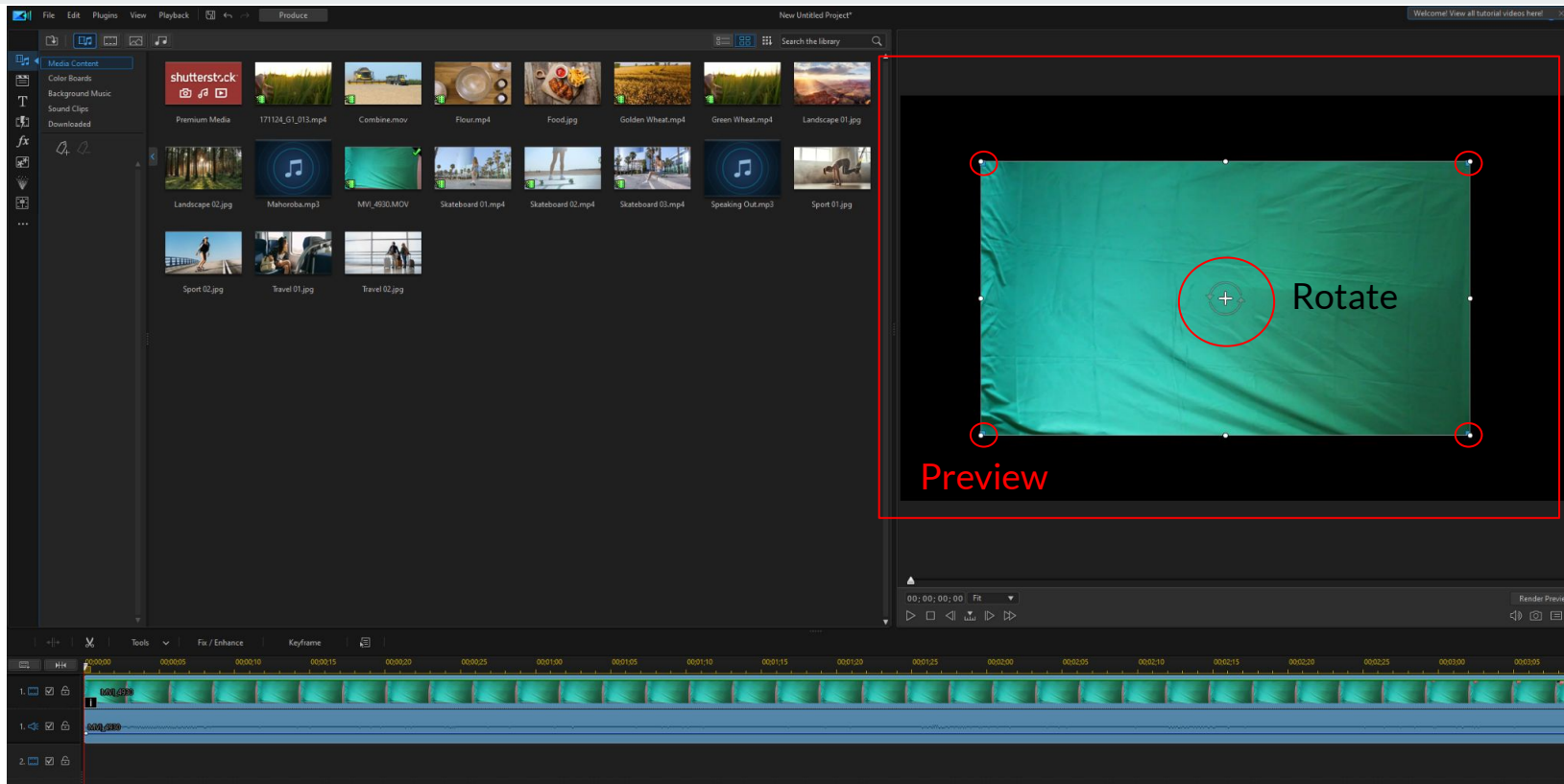
Crop Video

- Click OK



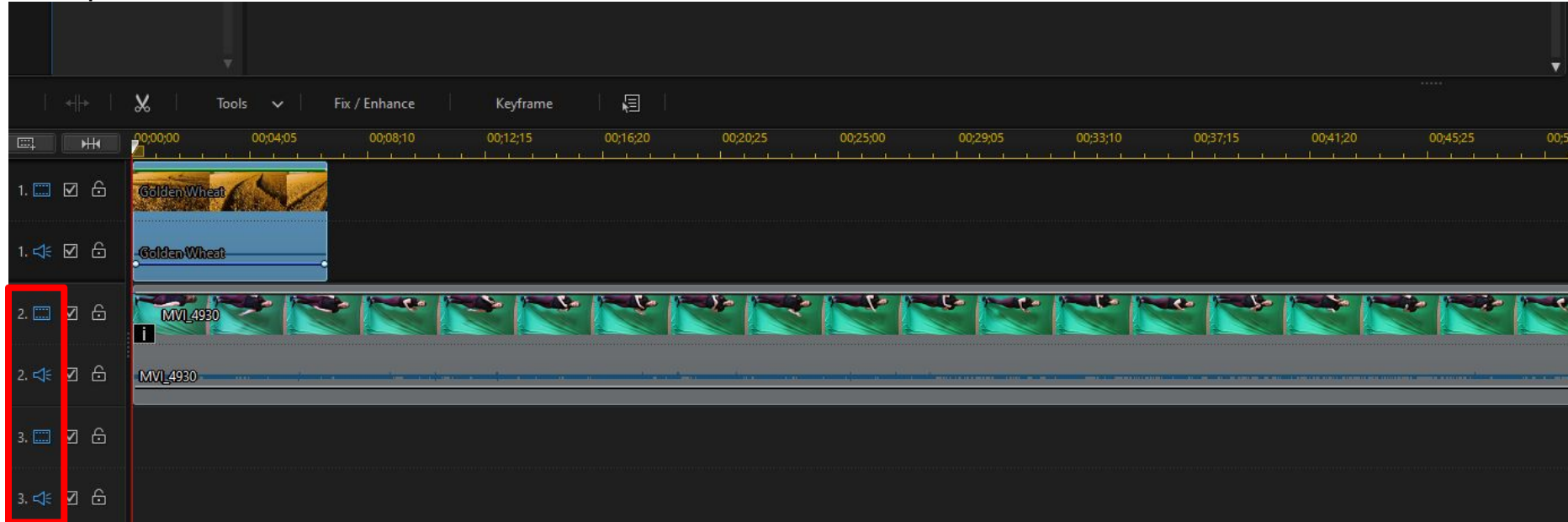
Resize and Rotate

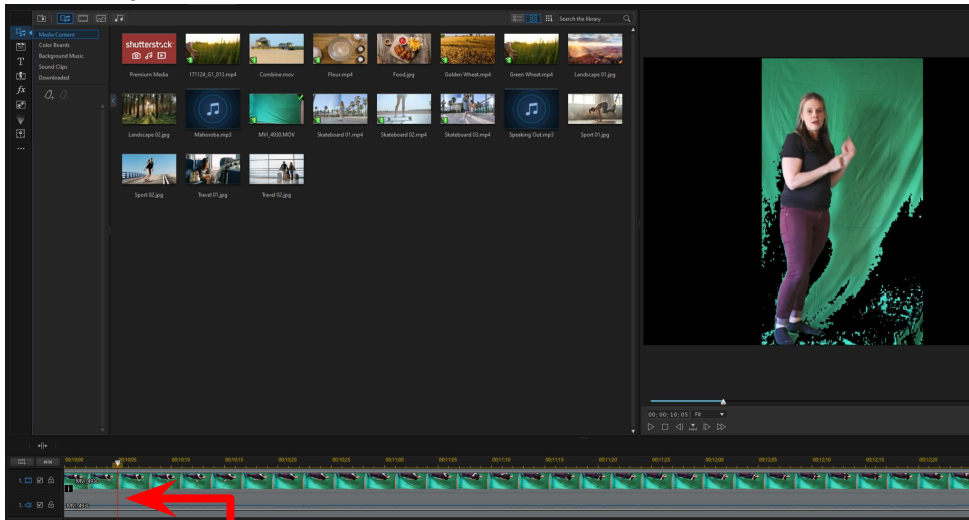


Note: Green Screen clip needs to be on Track 2 at least

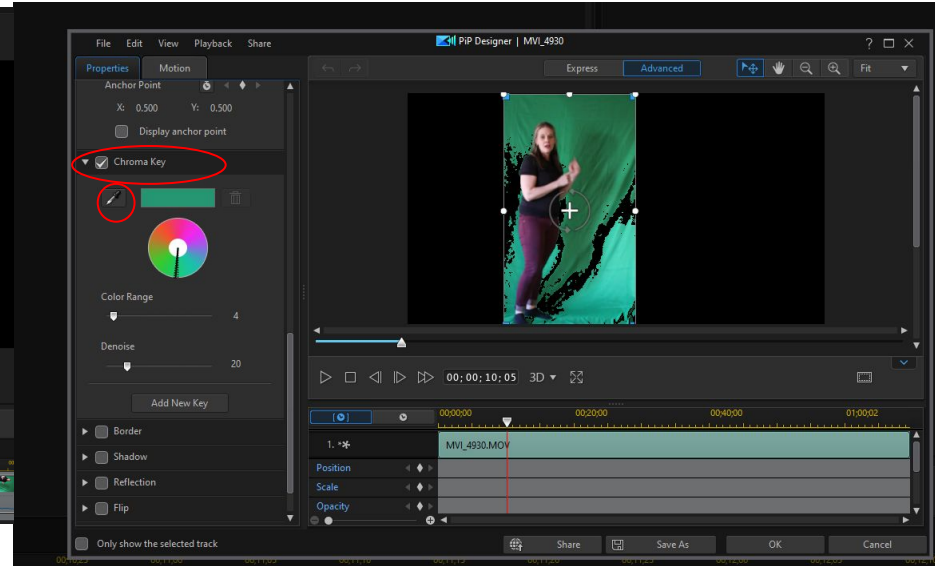

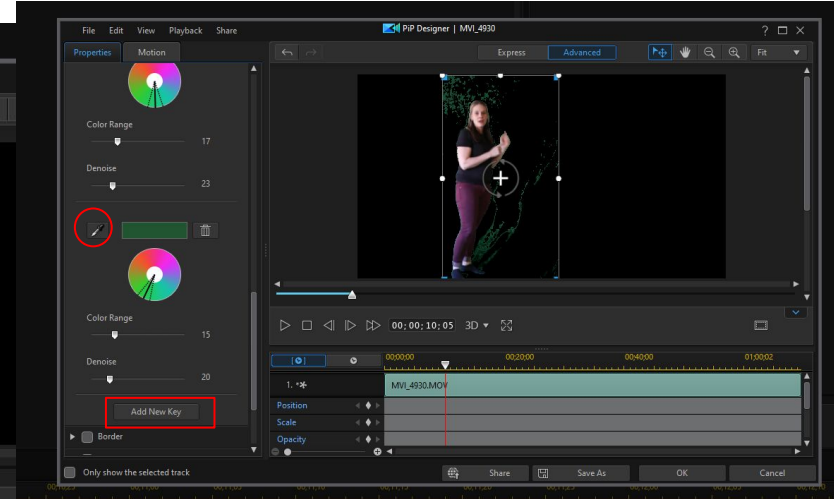
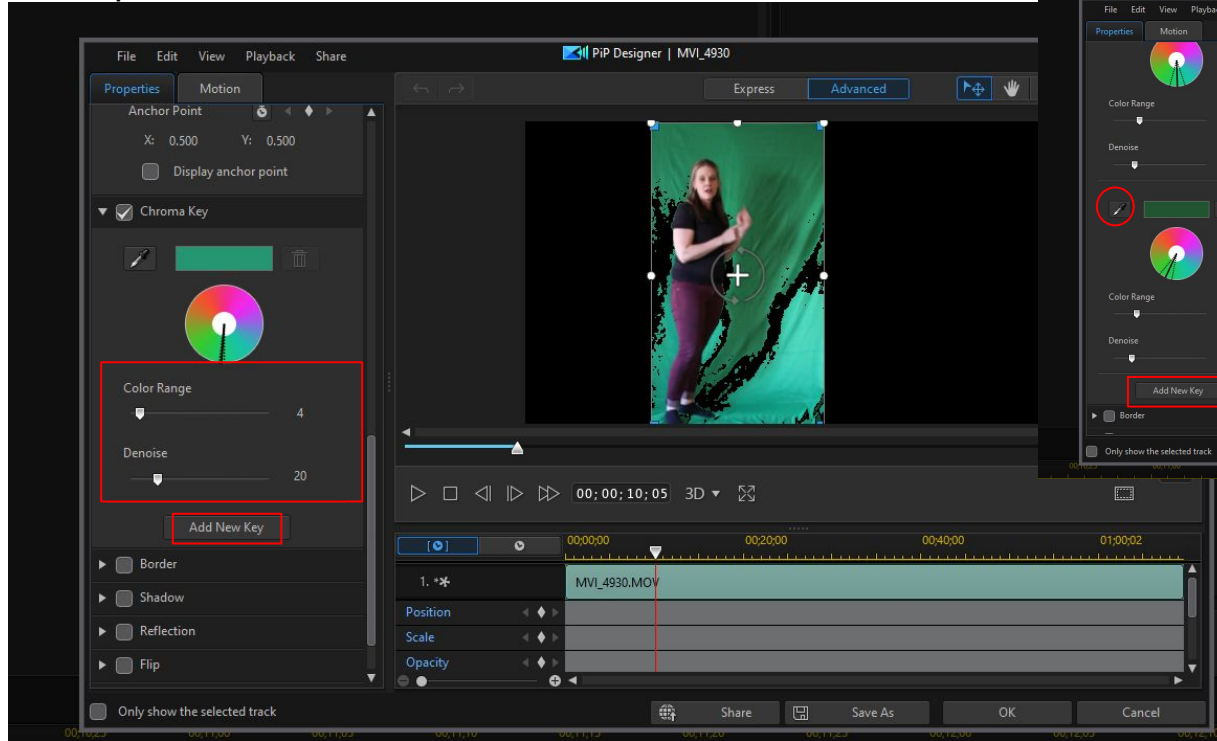
1. Have Play Head on a frame with a person in the frame

5. Click the Eyedropper
6. Click a green color

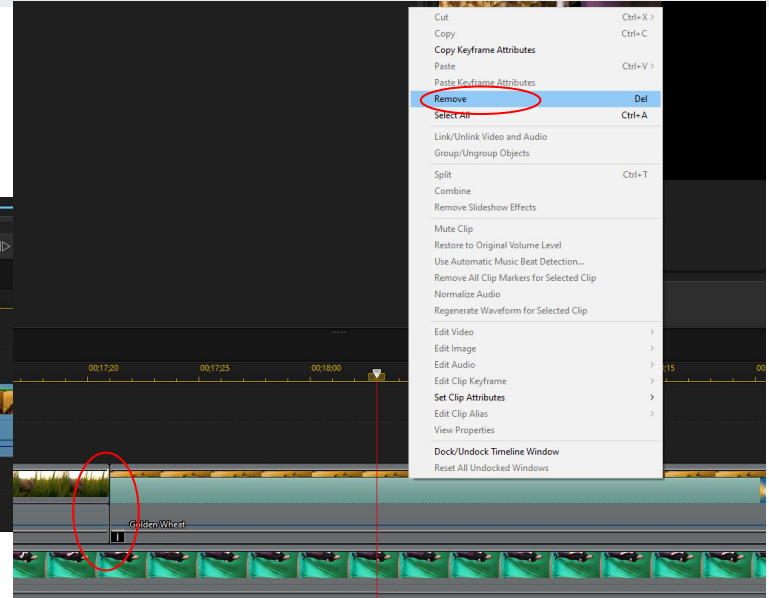
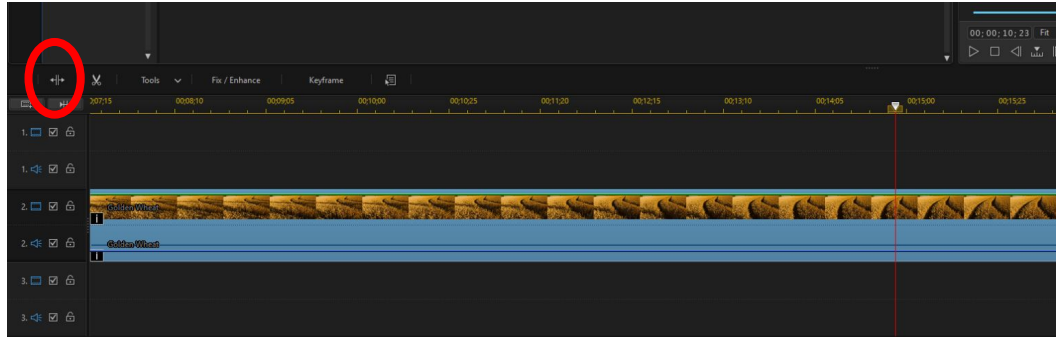
8. Click the Eyedropper

**The more green shades are select the more will disappear

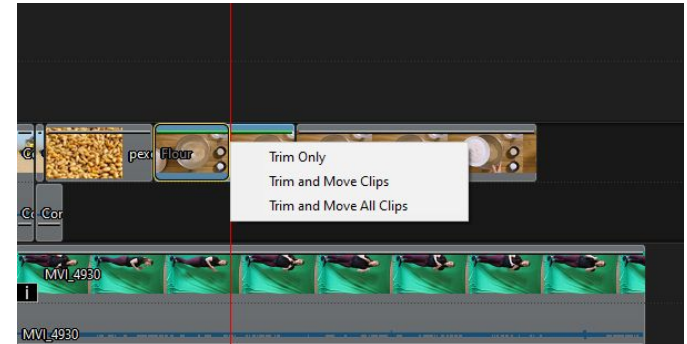
Split Video or Cut Video

Big cut use this Option

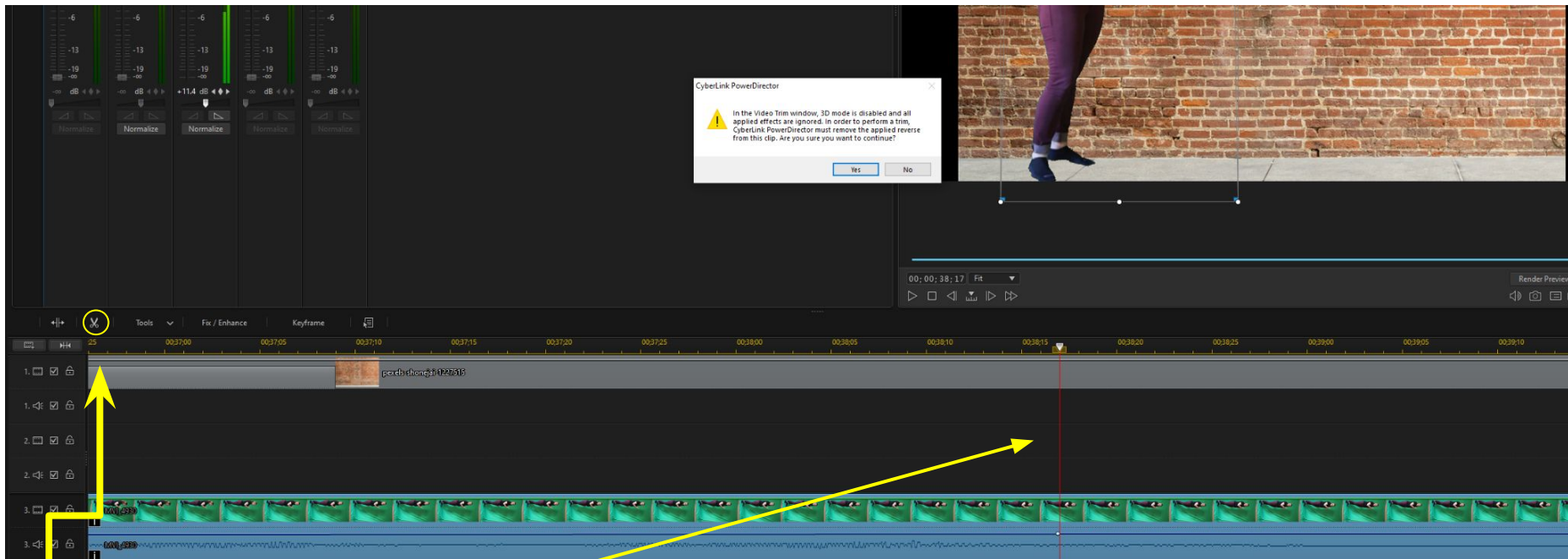


Click >> Split Icon

Make Small Cuts



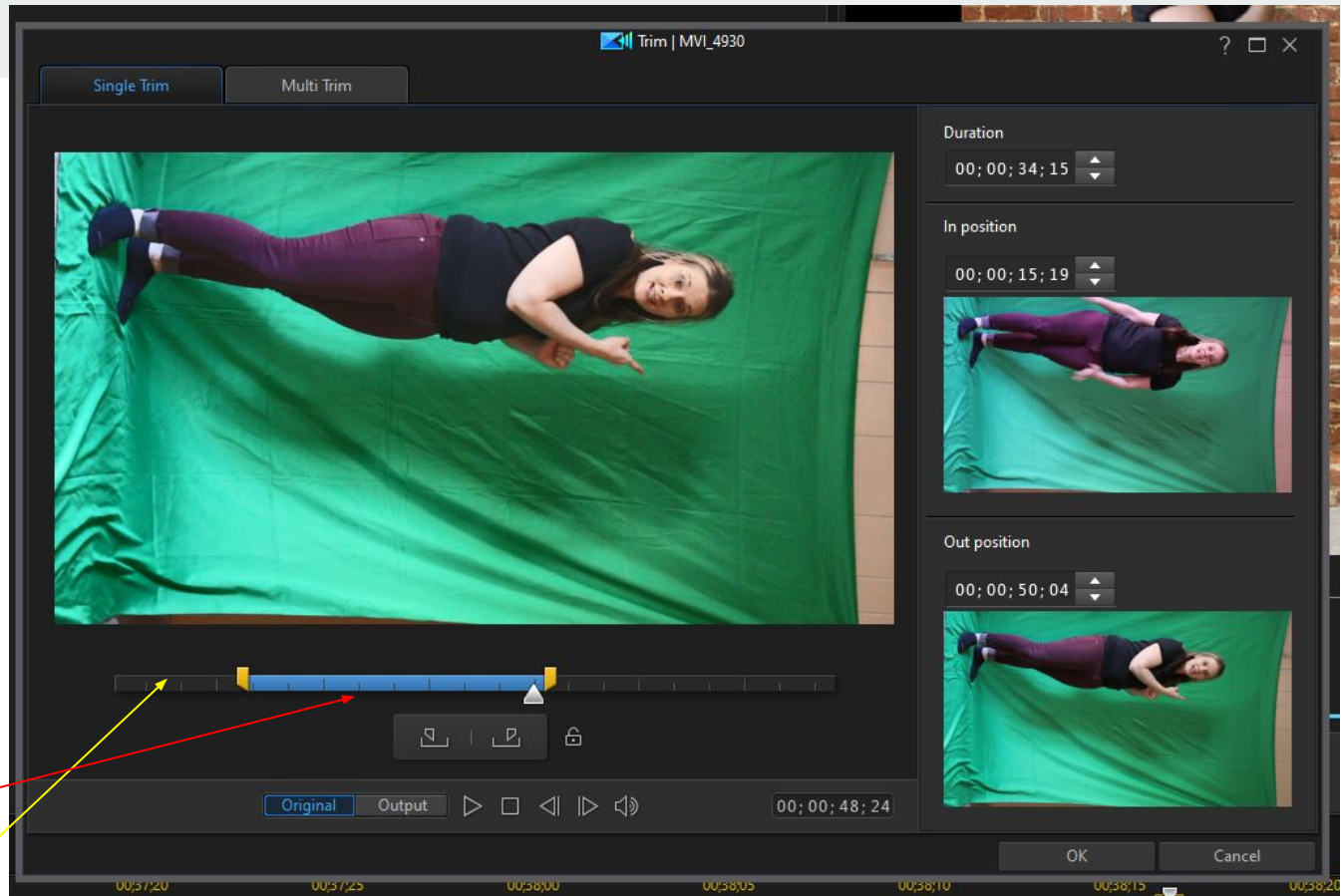

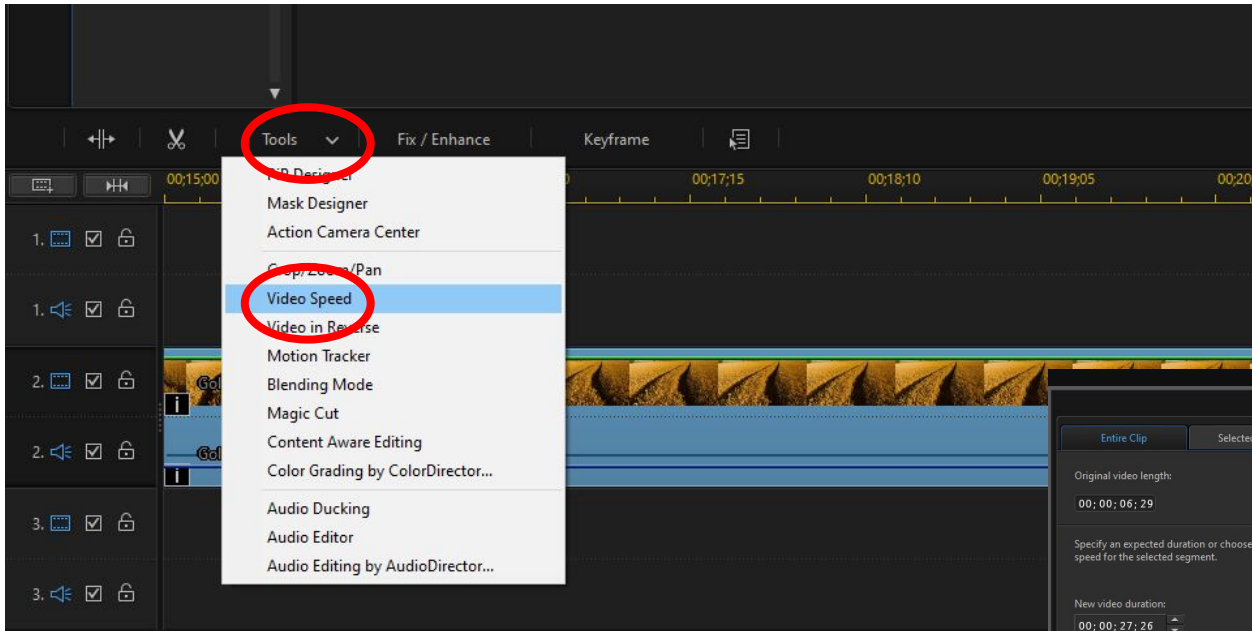
Trim a Clip



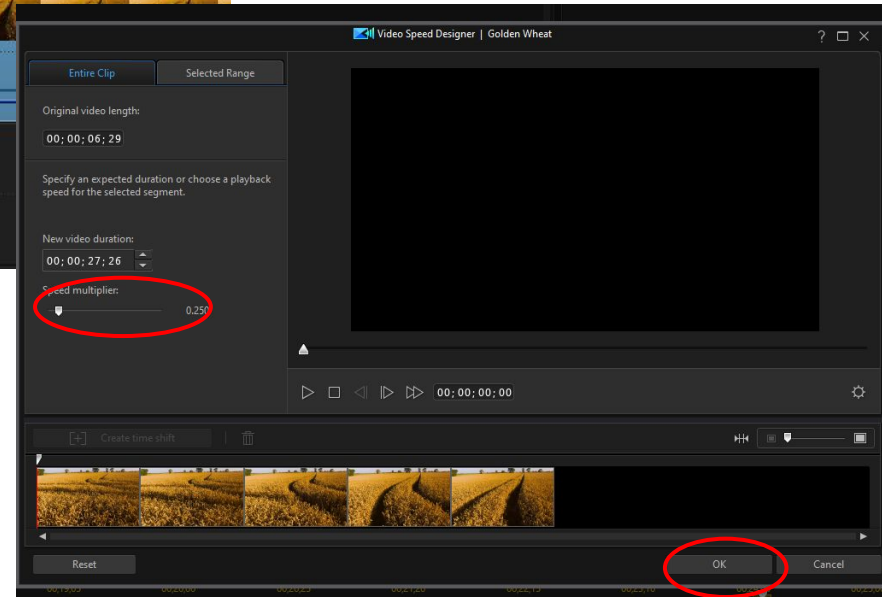
- Click the clip

- Will get you options



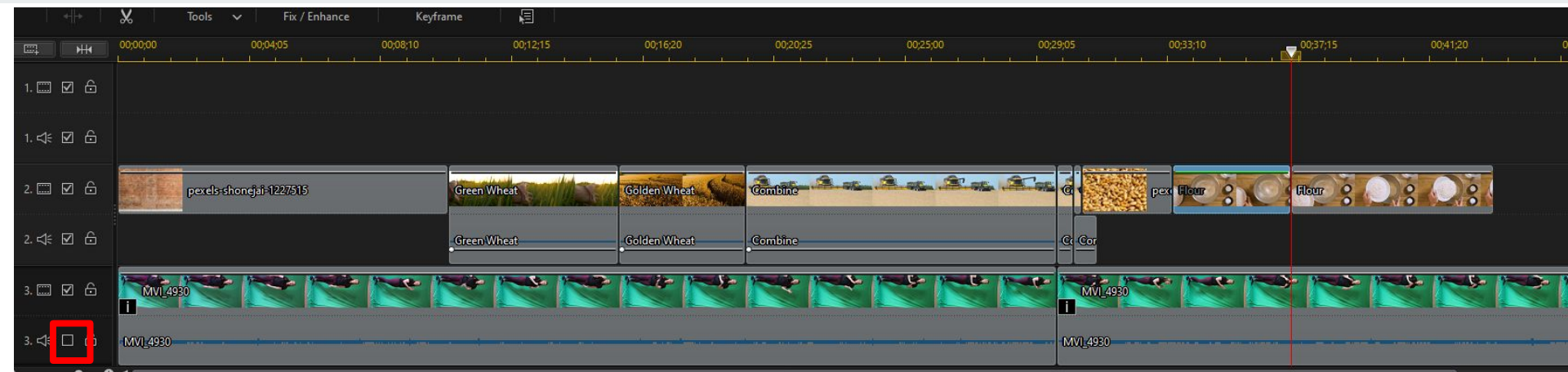
Slow Video Down or Up

Click Ok

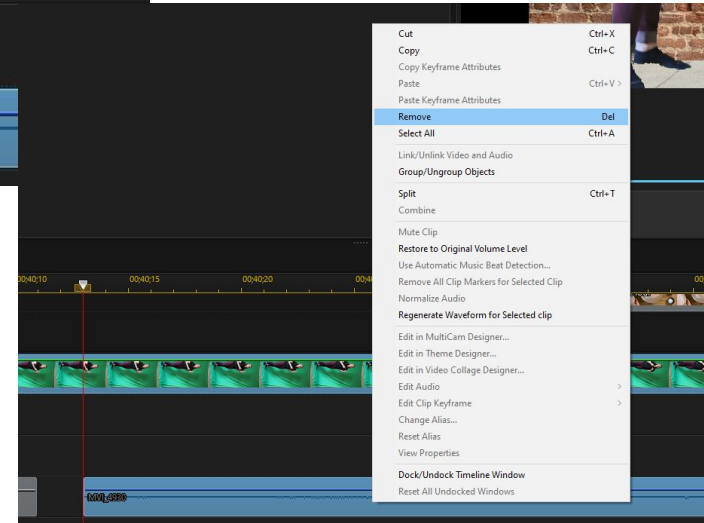
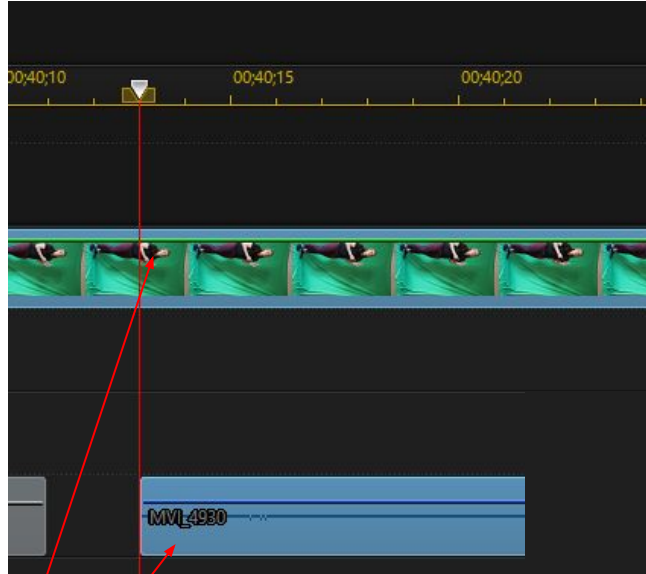
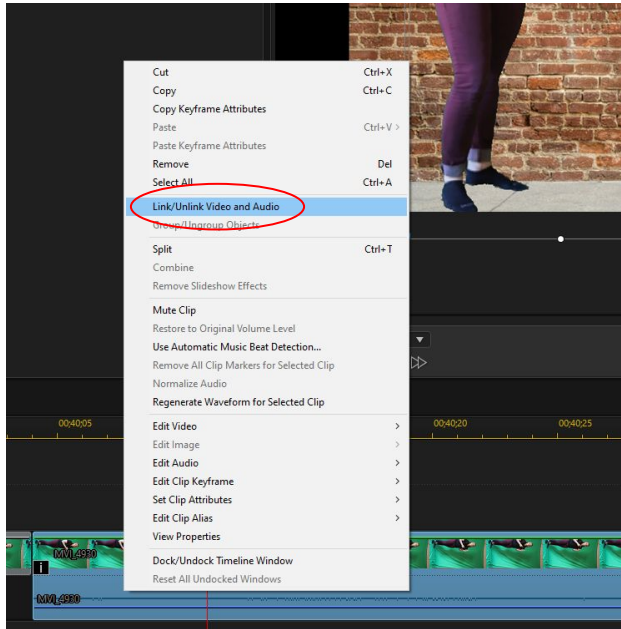


Silent Audio



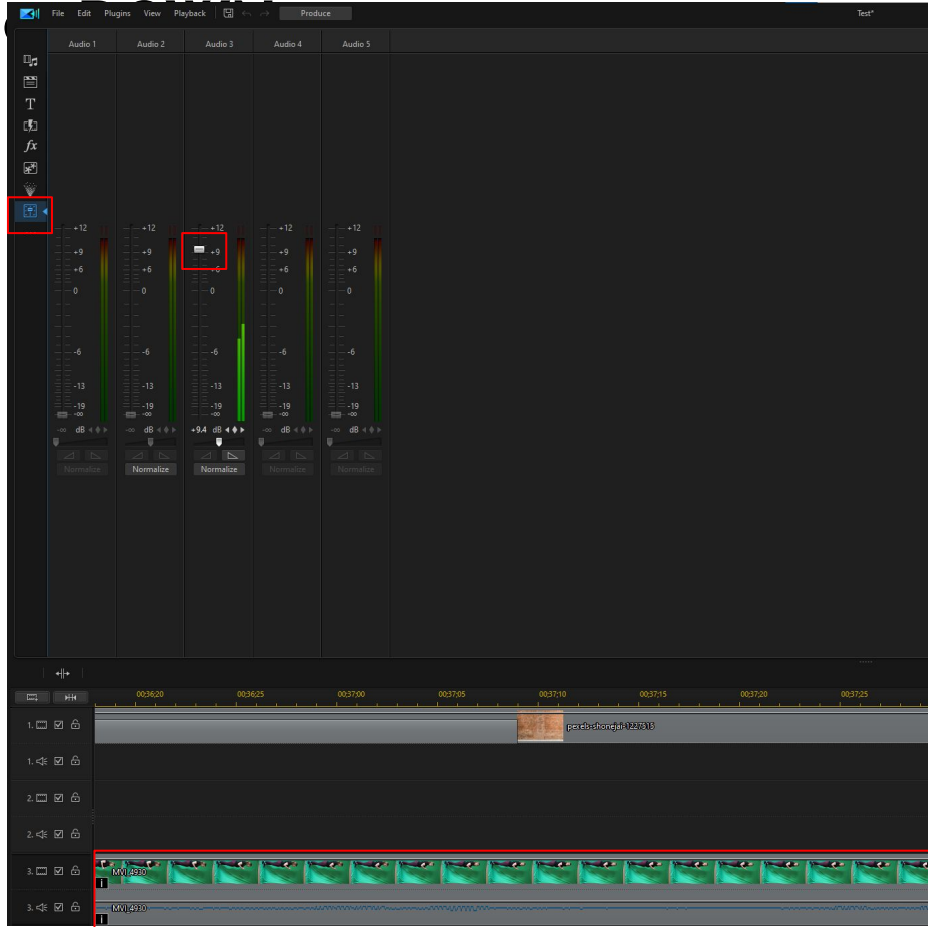
Uncheck the box in the track options

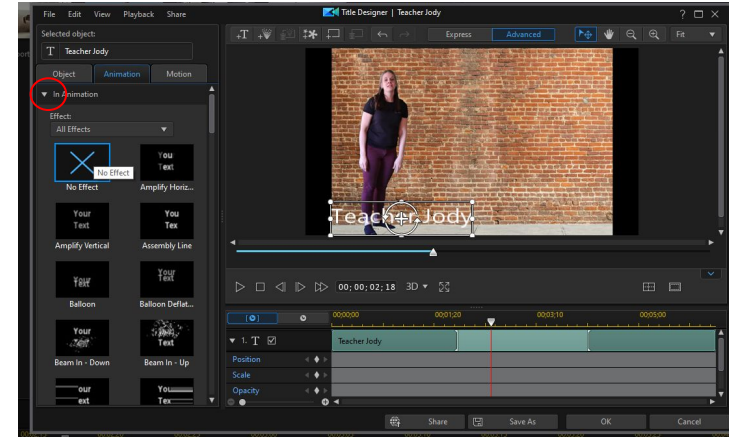
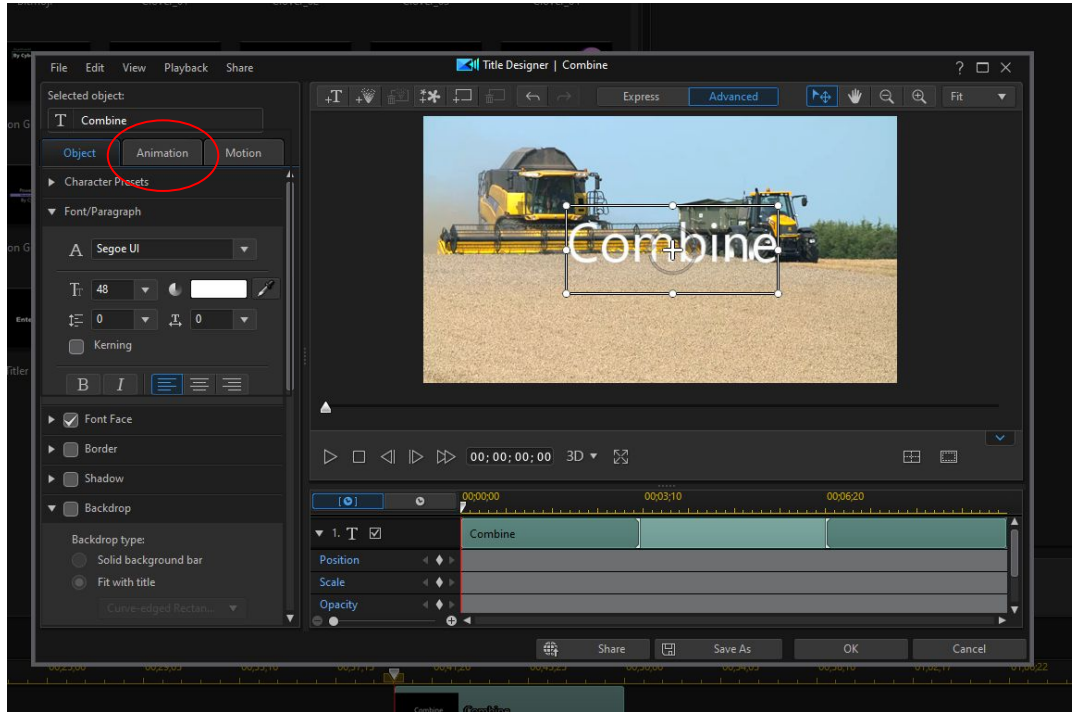
Note: If you can't see text look to see if you need to drag drop to lower level

- Click and Drag text to the a location

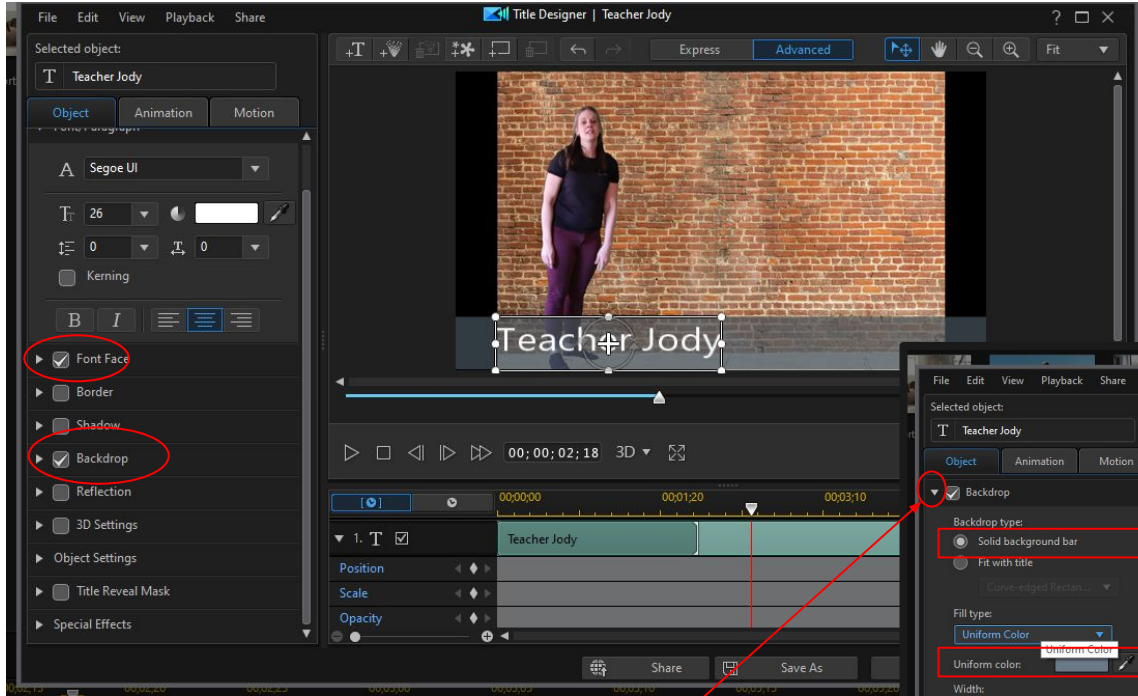
Advance Text: Double Click on Text Clip

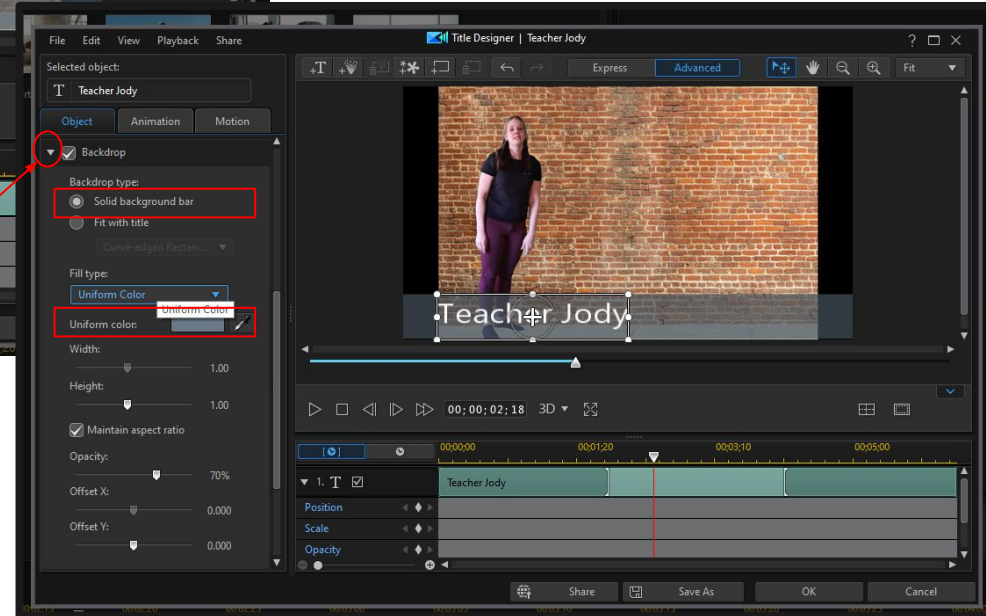


- Double Click the Text Clip

- Choose Animation

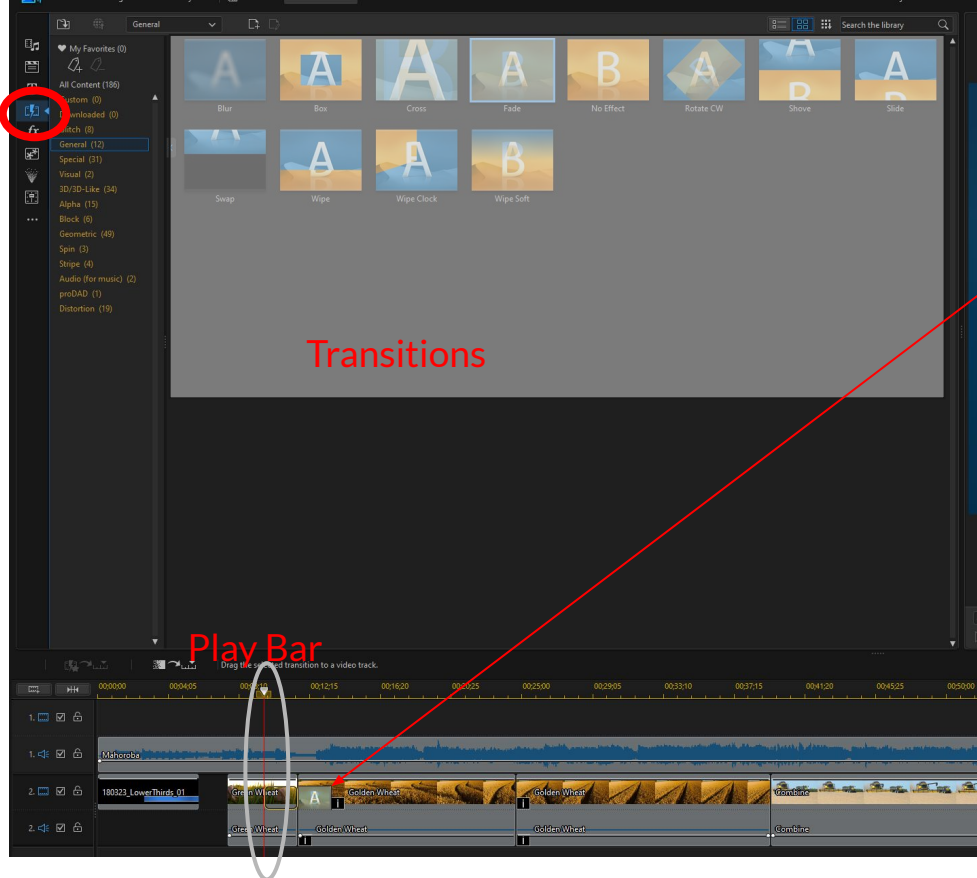
Advance Text - Title Bar

- Choose a Color-Uniform color



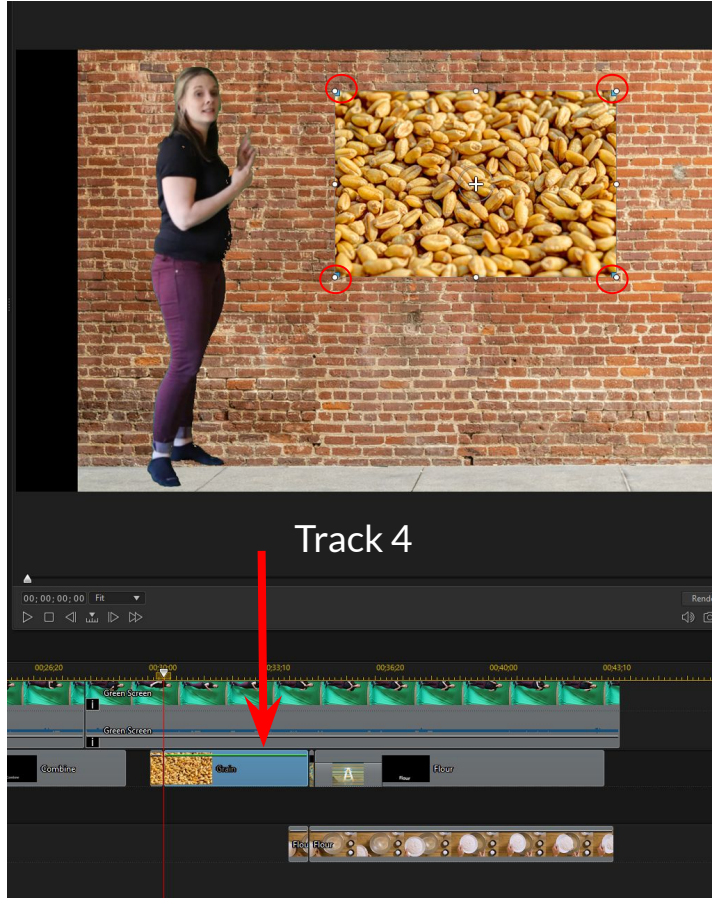
Transition

- Choose a Transition
- Select the length of the Transition by clicking the down Transition

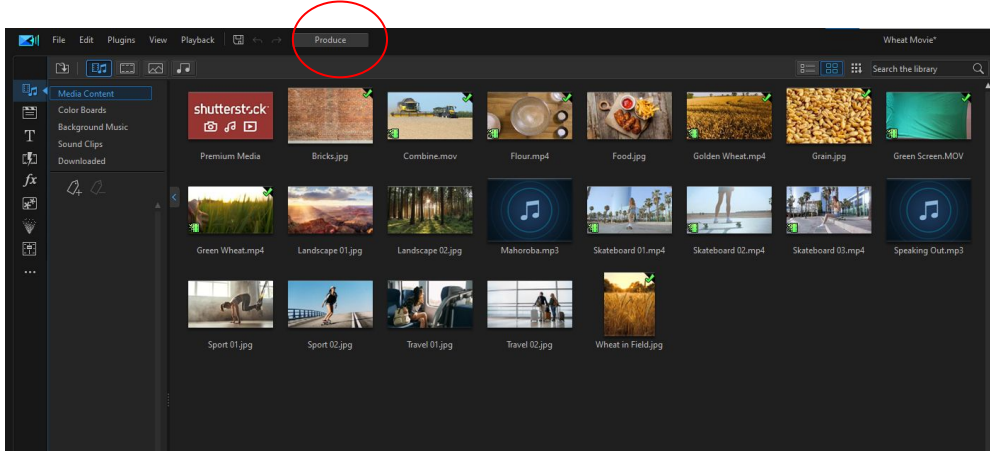
Notes you can also drag and drop the transitions in the timeline too.

Insert a Image

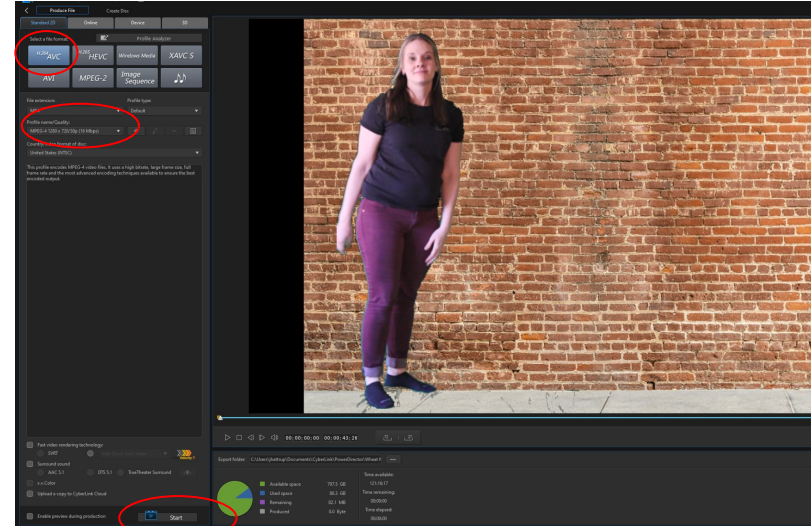


- Drag and Drop Image on Track 4, 5, and etc
